

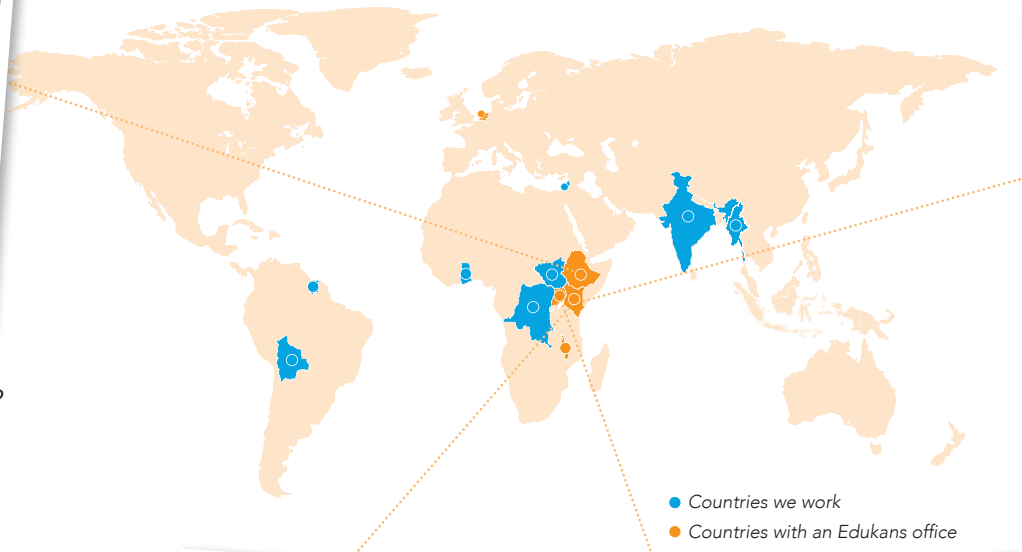
2021 in a nutshell



Our impact made great strides in 2021. We were able to provide 686,849 students with access to better and safer education. This gives these students an opportunity to build their future. Almost 10,000 teachers learned better ways to teach and 1,673 young people developed skills that will enable them to confidently enter the labour market and earn their own income.



During a dry season in Ethiopia, one in three students has to drop out of school: parents simply do not have the money for school, due to sky-high food prices. We started an emergency project. Through financial support, we were able to keep 5,320 children from vulnerable households in school. And 13,300 students from 27 schools got access to water.



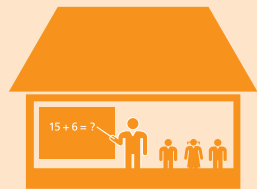
Without teaching materials and a good teacher, you will hardly learn anything in school. This changed for 442,690 children in Kenya, Malawi, Uganda, Ghana and Ethiopia. They received a Correctbook: an erasable notebook, that allows you to practise endlessly in class. Their 7,550 teachers improved their way of teaching. Teacher Elisabeth (Kenya): "Within a year's time, my students have now learned to write properly."

"Without this training I would still be unemployed. Now I have my own clothing boutique," Verah tells us, as she shows us around her shop, beaming with pride. Youth unemployment in Kenya increased due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This is why we also teach young people business skills. This is how they learn how to get to work as entrepreneurs.



It grieved us that students in Uganda were unable to attend school throughout the entire year 2021. We provided a flying start upon their return. 100 schools listed what they needed and together with teachers, school managements and parents, better lessons were provided.

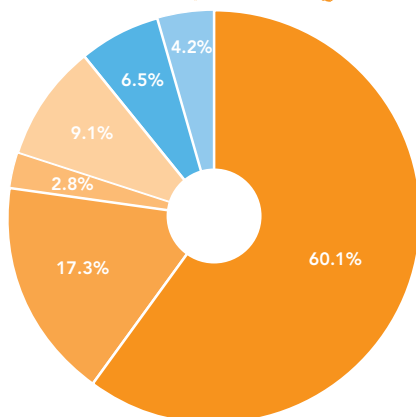
